During various discussions with members over the past month or so regarding a range of issues. We have taken this time to talk to various members within the community football space. We believe the proposed progression, that the current committee would like to implement as noted below is a timely and suitable way of the club moving forward.

Development of a Three Year Strategic Development Plan

The Development Plan comprises of, but is not limited to the review, consultation, communication and implementation of key points related to the overall development and improvement for the club and its members for the following three (3) seasons.

1. Consultation
 - This includes our club members, coaches, players, parents and Central Coast Football
2. Communication
 - The executive committee is committed to provide club members a "Members Bulletin" every 2 months (similar format to this one)
 - Provide members the opportunity to attend general meetings, as scheduled.
3. Coach Development
 - Age appropriate coach education.
 - Provide coaching support to assist with the Discovery Phase and Skills Acquisition Phase (SAP)
 - 1 v 1
 - Running with the Ball
 - Striking the ball
4. Junior Players Mentor Program
 - Provide the junior players a gauged direct association with a premier league teams, coach and players. Review the option of two or three senior players to be delegated a team. A pilot program was implemented at the end of last season with the W13 team and the SWL squad, as a short term trial process, we believe this was a success.

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Forecast Activities prior to the end of January

1. Continued communication with the members is a high priority.
2. U5 to U7 induction sessions for coaches, players and parents. Please keep an eye on our Facebook page and our club websites for updates.
3. Appointment of the mens BPL first grade coach
4. Set a date and venue for our first General Meeting
5. Review of the current Constitution

In the past three seasons our SWL and BPL squads, have been extremely successful. Winning five grand finals and competing in all semi-final series. We now need to look forward, by providing our current and future junior players an opportunity and a pathway to be the future SWL and BPL players of the future. This is not an “overnight process” however we believe the progression that we are putting forward for the 2017 season is a step in the right direction. The framework of our proposed *Three Year Strategic Development Plan* will provide a systematic approach in achieving our goals.
